

# Siamese Kitten

A free crochet pattern by Irka! [irkachan.blogspot.com](http://irkachan.blogspot.com) / [irka.com.ar](http://irka.com.ar)

## Materials:

Beige and dark brown yarn  
A crochet needle (size 4)  
Black and skyblue thread, needle.  
Some filling.

## Body (beige):

1- Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)  
2- 2sc in each sc around (12 sc)  
3- \*1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (18sc)  
4- \*2sc in first sc, 1sc in second sc, 1sc in third sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (24sc)  
5- \*2sc in first sc, 1sc in next three sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (30sc)  
6 to 9 rows - 1sc in each sc around (30 sc)  
10 - \*st2tog, sc in next three sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (24sc)  
11- 1sc in each sc around (24sc)  
12- \*st2tog, sc in next two sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (18sc)  
13- 1sc in each sc around (18sc)  
14- \*st2tog, sc in next sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (12sc)  
15 to 20 rows- 1sc in each sc around (12sc) Sl-st in the last sc.  
Close.

## Head (beige):

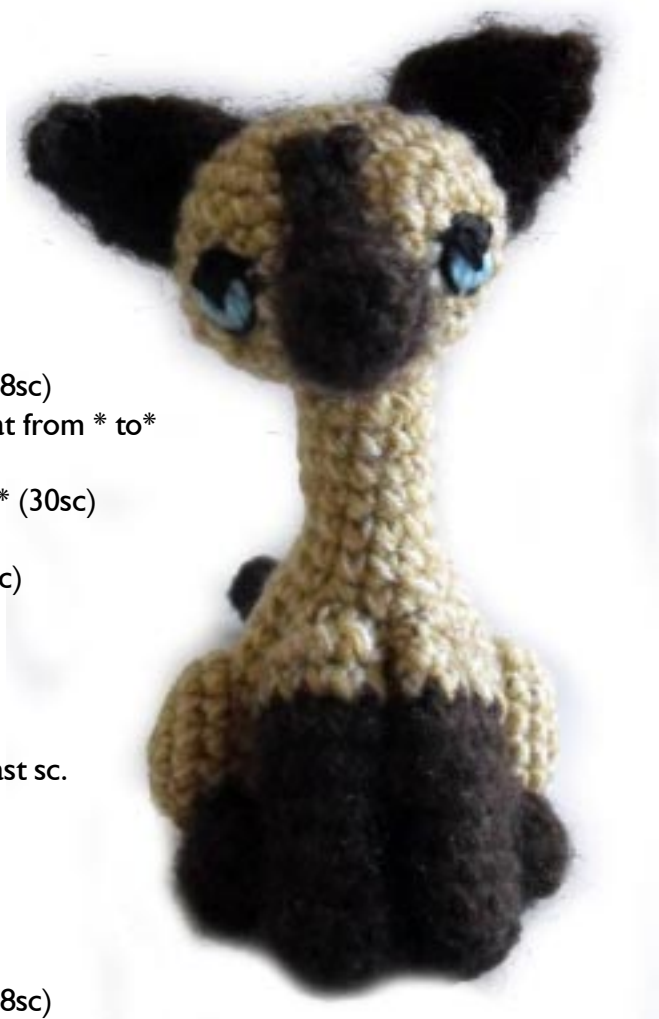
1- Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)  
2- 2sc in each sc around (12 sc)  
3- \*1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (18sc)  
4- \*2sc in first sc, 1sc in second sc, 1sc in third sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (24sc)  
5- \*2sc in first sc, 1sc in next three sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (30sc)  
6 to 8 rows - 1sc in each sc around (30 sc)  
9- \*st2tog, sc in next three sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (24sc)  
10- \*st2tog, sc in next two sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (18sc)  
11- \*st2tog, sc in next sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (12sc)  
12- st2tog all around (6sc)  
13- Close all tog.

## Nuzzle (brown):

1- Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)  
2- \*1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (9 sc)  
3- 1sc in each sc around (9sc)  
Ch 5, 1 sc in each st. Sl-st the next sc, close.

## Back Legs (top) make 2:

1- In Beige: Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)  
2- 2sc in each sc around (12 sc)





- 3- \* 1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (18sc)
- 4- Beige: 1sc in each sc around. Make in Brown the last 6 sc (18sc)
- 5- Beige: 1sc in each sc around. Make in Brown the last 7 sc (18sc). Sl-st the last sc, close.

**Back Legs (paws) make 2 (brown):**

- 1- Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)
- 2- \* 1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (9 sc)
- 3- 1sc in each sc around (9sc)
- 4- \*st2tog, sc in next two sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (7sc). Close.

**Front Legs, make 2:**

- 1- Brown: Magic Ring with 6 st (6 sc)
- 2- \* 1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (9 sc)
- Rows 3 to 8- 1sc in each sc around (9sc)
- Rows 9 and 10- Beige: 1sc in each sc around (9sc)

**Ears (brown) make 2:**

- 1- Ch 8.
  - 2- 1sc in each st. (7sc) (Do NOT ch after the last sc).
- Continue 1sc each sc, reducing naturally until the last row had just 2sc. Sl-st and close to make a triangle.

**Tail (Brown):**

- 1- Magic Ring with 5 st (5 sc)
  - 2- \* 1sc in first sc, 2sc in second sc\*, repeat from \* to\* (7 sc)
  - 3- 1sc in each sc around (7sc)
  - 4- St2tog, 1sc in the rest sc (6sc)
  - Rows 5 to 11- 1sc in each sc around (6sc).
- Close.

Fill up the head and body. Add some filling to the legs and tail (not so much, specially to the front legs) Pin all together to adjust and see where will be everything. Start sewing all parts together.

The "tail" left in the nuzzle will be the brown vertical mark between the eyes. You can use safety eyes for the face or just embroider a little. Don't make the eyes too small. Put 'em in the middle of the face, or lower to create a childish(kitten) and sweet look.
